REF: BRS REGISTRY SYSTEM UPGRADE

The Business Registration Service (BRS) has been undertaking a system enhancement project aimed at ensuring end to end automation of services across its three departments; Companies Registry, Insolvency and the Hire purchase registry. To ensure a smooth transition to the enhanced system, the Service embarked on a phased pilot program of a number of services on the enhanced system on 14th June, 2023.

The services onboarded so far on the pilot environment are as follows:

1. Registration of:
 - a. Business Name;
 - b. Company Limited by Guarantee;
 - c. Limited Liability Partnership;
 - d. Limited Partnership; and
 - e. Foreign company.
2. Post registration processes for Limited Partnership (Changes, official Search, Certified Copies).
3. Official Receiver, Natural person processes and Insolvency Practitioner License and renewal of Insolvency practitioner license processes.

The exercise is aimed at ensuring issues identified during piloting are addressed to facilitate smooth transition to the enhanced system and as a key stakeholder, the Service would like to extend an invitation to you to participate in this pilot program. We anticipate that your feedback will be valuable in the development of the system before Go-Live.

Once onboarded on the pilot environment, you will have the opportunity to submit real applications and have them reviewed and processed, as well as be able to provide input that will be considered in refining the system features and functionalities.
